Entrance Examination in August 2019 for Graduate School Admission 2020

Information and Hints for Examinees

The location for the written examination and the anteroom for oral examination (meeting place) will be stated on noticeboards related to the examination at each examination rooms from 10:00 a.m. the day before the examination. On the examination day, be sure to find the information posted at the sites, before going to the designated venue. You are not allowed to enter the room before the examination day.

1. Information and Regulations for the Examination

- (1) Make sure you keep your Reference Card with you throughout the examination.
- (2) Take your seat in the examination room 15 minutes prior to the start of each subject examination. Turn off any alarms on your mobile phone, smartphone, etc., switch it off, and put it in your bag before entering the room. Do the same with wearable devices including smart watches and smart glasses, etc.
- (3) Since there is no clock in the each examination rooms, bring your own watch with you. Cell phone / PHS, smart phone or those of any kinds cannot be used as a watch. As for wearable devices such as a wristwatch-type smart watch and an eyeglass-type smart glass, they must be treated just the same as a mobile phone and a PHS. They are not permitted to be used as a clock. They must be turned off and must be placed in a bag before implementation of the examination.
- (4) Examinees who arrived late will be permitted to take the examination only when such lateness is within 30 minutes of the start of the examination. If such lateness was caused by an unavoidable reason such as a transportation accident, report to the corresponding head office of the examination venue (refer to 5. Contact numbers of Head Offices of Examination Venues on page 2) and ask for instruction.
- (5) Pay attention to the weather and allow enough time to get to the venue in time.
- (6) Place your Reference Card on the side of the desktop where your examinee number is indicated throughout the writing examinations.
If you have lost your Reference Card, report to the corresponding head office of the examination venue (See 5. Contact Numbers of Head Office of Examination Venues on page 2)
- (7) Make sure you follow the schedule and take all specified examinations. If an examinee failed to take any of the specified examinations, such examinee will be regarded as absent and therefore ineligible for selection.
- (8) As for examinations assigned as a result of preliminary selection, examinees are not permitted to take subjects other than those initially selected.
- (9) Take care when filling out your examinee's number and names of the Graduate School and Program you apply for in the specified spaces on the answer sheet.
(An answer sheet with the number or names not filled out or unreadable will not be marked.)
- (10) For writing examinations, examinees are not permitted to use tools other than writing tools (pencils or mechanical pencils and erasers) and those specified by the corresponding Graduate School. Writing tools will not be loaned to examinees.
- (11) If an examinee commits a dishonest or obstructive act, an immediate exit from the room will be ordered and further taking of examination will not be permitted. In addition, the results of examinations of the examinee took before the act will be invalidated.
- (12) Examinees are not permitted to exit the room within 30 minutes after the start of examination.
- (13) If you have a question about the examination questions, raise your hand to ask it and follow instructions by the supervisor.
- (14) If you need to exit the room before the end of the examination, raise your hand and say you need to leave the room and follow instructions given by the supervisor.

- (15) When the end of examination is announced, put down your writing tools immediately and follow instructions given by the supervisor.
- (16) When collecting answer sheets, question sheets, and scribbling sheets, follow instructions given by the supervisor.
- (17) Examinees of oral examinations are to follow the guidance shown on notice boards for entrance examination information.
- (18) Follow any other instructions given by the supervisor.

2. General Notice

- (1) Pay attention to the update information, related to the examination.
- (2) Confirm the location of your examination room stated on the noticeboards beforehand, although entering the rooms is not allowed before the examination day.
- (3) Since the cafeteria close to the examination rooms will be crowded on the day, we therefore recommend you to bring your own lunch.
- (4) We will not arrange any accommodation for this examination.

Please be careful, there may well be some people who persuade you to receive a telegram of unauthorized reporting of test results they sent, but we have not any concern in them. The people, who pretend to be the University staff, might wait anywhere around the testing locations, stations, etc. Those are NOT connected with us. We will not take responsibility for such kind of solicitation.

3. Announcement of Acceptance

The examinee numbers of successful applicants will be published on University of Tsukuba Web site (<https://entry.ap-graduate.tsukuba.ac.jp/>) and letters of acceptance will be dispatched to them by registered mail on the same day.


