Due to the ongoing effects of the new coronavirus pandemic, score reports for the TOEFL iBT test and TOEFL iBT Home Edition for the academic year 2022 at the University of Tsukuba are to be submitted as outlined below.

When applying using the TOEFL iBT test and TOEFL iBT Home Edition score reports, it is necessary to submit within the stated time-frame the original Test Taker Score Report mailed to the examinee from ETS. However, given the effects of the new coronavirus pandemic, it is possible that mailing of the Test Taker Score Report will be delayed for some time.

If you assume that you will not be able to submit within the stated time-frame the original Test Taker Score Report mailed to the examinee from ETS, please make sure that you carry out procedures ① and ② as described below. If you fail to do so and are unable to submit the original Test Taker Score Report as requested, your application may be rejected or excluded from screening on the grounds of non-attendance.

(1) Test Taker Score Report

If you believe the original mailed to the examinee from ETS will not arrive in time to meet the submission deadline, please carry out the procedure described in ② and then print out the PDF version downloaded from the ETS account and submit this by the submission deadline stated on the Application Guidelines. As soon as the original Test Taker Score Report arrives, please also submit this

If any false information has been recorded on the submitted score report, the application or pass will be withdrawn.

2 Official Score Report

Please carry out the procedure for the Official Score Report to be sent directly from ETS to the University of Tsukuba. Score information will be sent to the University once the procedure has been completed at ETS. If data does not arrive at the University by the submission deadline stated on the Application Guidelines, your application may be rejected or excluded from screening on the grounds of non-attendance. It may take one week or longer for the data to be received by the University, so please carry out the procedure well in advance. (Institution (DI) Code: 9995, Department Code: 99)
