1		Please confirm your Zoom connection (Zoom account) with the World Heritage Studies degree program staff at least one day before the exam and provide them with a phone number where they can contact you if there are any problems with the Zoom connection.
2		You should prepare for Zoom connection and be present at the place where the interview will take place, 20 minutes before the examination starts.
3		You should show the room to the World Heritage Studies degree program staff where the interview will take place in order to confirm that the room is closed, and that the applicant is the only person present.
4		You should share your presentation files by yourself and should send them to the World Heritage Studies degree program staff beforehand by the due date.
5		Please ensure that your appearance on the day of the examination is the same as in your photograph form (hairstyle, glasses, etc.). If the candidate's identity cannot be properly confirmed, the examination will not take place.

Please note that a correspondence test will be conducted prior to the entrance exam. The date, time, and other details will be sent to you by e-mail from the World Heritage Studies degree program.
