

## Online Entrance Examination for Overseas Residents

Entrance examinations are held at the University Testing Center.

In some exceptional circumstances, the International Development and Peace through Sport (IDS) program will offer the entrance examination through an online platform for overseas residents who wish to take the examination. If an examinee wishes to take the entrance examination, the examinee must communicate with a prospective academic advisor and receive an approval.

Information environment and other requirements for taking the online entrance examination.

The following preparations and arrangements are required when the online entrance examinations are held.

- 1. Ensure your room is bright and quiet Have a bright quiet private room environment
- 2. Ensure your internet connection is secured (make sure you can send and receive videos) Have a network environment capable of sending and receiving video
- 3. Ensure your personal computer is equipped with camera and microphone Have a personal computer with a camera and microphone  
(Using a speaker as voice output. as well as earphones or headphones, etc., it is prohibited that these items are attached to your body that are fitted to the body are prohibited)
- 4. Have a smartphone (with a camera) \* Item 4 on the left is for emergency use in case of occurrence of network problems

We will conduct an online connectivity test with the examinee before the exam day. We will provide you a detail later.
