Applicants for Master's Program in Art must submit a thesis (Art History and Art Environment Support only) and/or portfolio according to the field of study they wish to pursue. Applicants who do not submit a thesis (Art History and Art Environment Support only) and portfolio will not be allowed to take the examination.

Art History	Graduation thesis (or equivalent)	Upload a PDF to the University of Tsukuba Online Storage (UTOS). Upload instructions will be notified on the web entry completion screen. NOTES: •Name the PDF file using the following format: Examination Number_Field of Research_Your Full Name (as entered in the online application). •The cover page of the PDF must include Examination Number, Field of Research, and Full Name (as entered in the online application). The position and size are optional. •Compress the PDF to maximum around 50MB. •If you have large files such as movies, upload the file to a video streaming site such as YouTube, or a cloud storage such as Google Drive, or your own website, and include the link URL in the portfolio PDF. If the file is limited sharing, include password or other information necessary for viewing.
