(Important) Method of Implementation of Graduate School Entrance Examinations (October) for Academic Year 2023

The Graduate School entrance examinations scheduled for October 12 to October 19 will be held at the university's examination venues, with the thorough implementation of novel coronavirus COVID-19 infection-control measures.

(However, online entrance examinations will be held for examinees for some master's or doctoral programs (*1) and for those permitted to take supplementary examinations (*2).)

For entrance to the university's examination venues, please comply with the <u>points to note</u> regarding undertaking examinations for prevention of spread of new coronavirus COVID-19 <u>infections</u>. In addition, please record your daily temperature, etc., for 14 days including the day of the examination, on the <u>Health Observation Record Table</u> (For Graduate School Entrance Examinations), and bring it with you to the examination venue.

If the entrance examination testing method is affected by the situation regarding continuing expansion of infections within the university and its surroundings, etc., up until the date of the examination, the Graduate Admissions website will promptly announce it.

Note that in cases in which (1) an examinee has displayed symptoms such as fever or coughing during the 14-day health observation period and has not recovered by the date of the examination, (2) an examinee resident overseas is restricted from entering or leaving Japan, or (3) an examinee becomes infected with COVID-19 or is deemed to have come into close contact with an infected person and continue to standby at home, the examinee will not be permitted to sit the examination at the examination venue. A supplementary online examination will be held, so apply to the office responsible for receiving applications (the destination for submission of application documents). - (*2) Entrance examinations will be performed online for examinees permitted to take the supplementary examination (including those being processed).
