## TOEFL iBT test and TOEFL iBT Home Edition for Graduate School Entrance Examination for Academic University of Tsukuba

The method of submitting TOEFL iBT and TOEFL iBT Home Edition scores for the graduate school entrance examination (conducted in 2024 academic year) will be handled as follows.

The following two methods of submitting TOEFL iBT scores for the graduate school entrance examination are acceptable.

## Method 1 (Submission of "Test Taker Score Report (original)")

If you have (or expect to receive by the application deadline) the original Test Taker Score Report mailed to you by ETS in the U.S., please submit the original Test Taker Score Report by the deadline specified in the application guidelines.

## Method 2 (Submission of "Official Score Report" by direct delivery to the university) \*Both procedures (1) and (2) are required.

- (1) If you do not receive the "Test Taker Score Report (original)" by the submission deadline, please follow the procedure for the score data (Official Score Report) to be sent directly to the university from ETS in the U.S. Score information will be sent to the university after the procedure is completed at ETS. The Official Score Report is sent directly from ETS to the university.
  - The Official Score Report data must be received by the university by the submission deadline specified in the application guidelines.
  - It may take several weeks for the university to receive the data, so please allow plenty of time to complete the process. (Institution (DI) Code: 9995, Department Code: 99)
- (2) After completing the procedures in (1) above, please print out the "Test Taker Score Report (PDF version)" downloaded from your ETS account and submit it by the submission deadline specified in the application guidelines.
  - If any false information is found on the submitted score sheet, your application will be rejected or your acceptance will be cancelled.
- \*If either Method 1 "Test Taker Score Report (original)" or Method 2 "Official Score Report (data) sent directly to the university" is not submitted by the deadline specified in the application guideline, the application will be rejected, or the applicant will be treated as absent and will not be considered.
- \*Valid external English proficiency test score sheets and submission deadlines vary by degree program admissions, so please check the application guidelines for each degree program.
