Changes to the FY2026 Entrance Examination for the **Master's Program in Disability Sciences**, Degree Programs in Comprehensive Human Sciences, Graduate School of Comprehensive Human Sciences (update)

Master's Program in Disability Sciences, Degree Programs in Comprehensive Human Sciences, Graduate School of Comprehensive Human Sciences will abolish the General Selection Process held in January and February as follows, starting with the entrance examination for the Master's Level Section of the 2026 academic year (held in the 2025 academic year). **In addition, the score sheet for the English external examination is required for the General Selection Process. Information has been updated since the February 5, 2024 notice.**

2: The score sheet for the English external examination is required (General Selection Process)

Before the change

Applicants who meet either of the following requirements will be exempt from the English examination and will receive a full score in English.

(A) Applicants who have received or will receive a degree from a university accredited by the U.S. Department of Education

(B) Applicants who have received or will receive a degree from a university where English is the language of instruction. If you fulfill this requirement, you must submit an official document from your university that certifies that English is the language of instruction at your institution.

After the change

There are no exemptions from submitting score sheet. It is required for all applicants.

If the original copy cannot be submitted at the time of application, the applicant must bring the original copy by no later than 3 days before the examination date.
