Information and Instructions for Examinees (Online)

Please note the following points those who will be undertaking University of Tsukuba Graduate School entrance examinations online in August Selection Process 2026.

※Please refer to “Information and Instructions for Examinees (At the University’s Examination Venues)” those who will be undertaking the examination at the University’s Examination Venue.

※Examinees for the Master’s and Doctoral Programs in Informatics, please read and prepare yourself in accordance with Information and Instructions for Examinees issued by Master’s and Doctoral Programs in Informatics. (<https://informatics.tsukuba.ac.jp/en/admission-information-en/admission/examination/>).

1. Please prepare the following environment and devices to undertake online examinations in advance.

① A bright and quiet private room where you can take examination alone.

② An internet device to communicate via web camera.

③ A personal computer with a camera and microphone.

(Please do not use listening devices to wear by yourself such as earphone or headphone, etc. You may use a speaker for voice output.)

④ A smartphone with a camera. (In case of emergency when network problem occurs)

⑤ An official ID with a photograph of yourself, other than the examination slip.

⑥ Any other items that your master’s or doctoral degree program ask you to prepare in advance.

2. We will conduct a communication test in advance to make sure you have a proper network environment.

3. Please print the document “Written Agreement Regarding Undertaking Online Examination”, sign your name on it, and submit it to the office in charge of receiving applications (the destination for submission of application documents) by the day before the examination day. However, if you have already submitted it at the time of application, you do not need to resubmit it.

4. Precautions

If you are unable to connect due to network or other problems on the day of the examination, please contact the head office. If you are not connected 10 minutes after the designated time to show up (meeting time) and you do not contact the head office by phone, you will be considered absent.

Please be sure to have your Reference Card with you during the exam. Please also have a photo ID (e.g. student ID, Driver’s license, Residence card, My Number Card, or Passport) ready. In addition to your Reference Card, you may be asked to present this ID for identity verification or other purposes.

During the examination, please do not place any of these unauthorized devices within easy reach. If such a device is left within easy reach, it may be regarded as an instance of cheating, even if it is not being used.

Written Agreement Regarding Undertaking Online Examination

I agree to all the following items regarding undertaking University of Tsukuba Graduate School entrance examinations online.

(1) The following items may be performed as necessary during the online examination.

- ① In addition to the Reference Card, I may be asked to show an official certificate certifying my identity (certificate with a facial photograph, such as a driver's license, passport, Resistance Card, My Number card, student card, etc.) as necessary.
- ② Recording may be conducted during the examination when the person in charge of the examination determines that it is necessary.
- ③ Depending on the circumstances, the examination may be discontinued and checks may be conducted for the presence or absence of fraudulent acts.
- ④ In addition, other actions that the person in charge of the examination has determined are necessary for the prevention of fraud and smooth conduct of the examination may be performed.

(2) The following items are considered to be fraudulent actions for the online examination.

- ① Leaking to the outside any of the contents regarding the examination, including the pre-connection test, by any means such as sound recording, video recording, external communication, etc.
- ② Communication with a person by any means, whether electronic or not, during the online examination. In addition, answering by obtaining cooperation from others.
- ③ Any violation of the instructions of the person in charge of the examination in connection with above (1).

(3) If any misconduct including the above (2) is found during the examination, the examination will be discontinued, you will be disqualified, and even if you have passed your admission will be canceled.
