2. Details of the Changes

Changes to the screening criteria for the Oral Examination regarding the examination language (including the addition of English-language questions and answers and English proficiency evaluation)

【Before the Change】

Based on the research plan submitted at the time of application, applicants will be individually evaluated on their research theme and aspirations, the logic that led to the conception of the research plan, and the state of their preparation.

【After the Change】

Based on the research plan submitted at the time of application, applicants will be individually evaluated on their research theme and aspirations, the logic that led to the conception of the research plan, and the state of their preparation. **In addition, a portion of the oral examination concerning the research plan will be conducted in English, and English proficiency will also be evaluated.**

※ There will be **no change to the score allocation** resulting from this revision:

- Specialized Subject: **200 points**
- Foreign Language: **200 points**
- Oral Examination: **400 points**
